



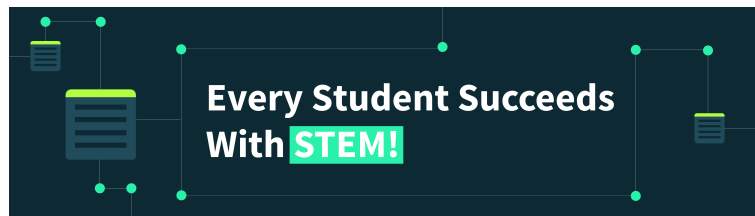

State	Mention of STEM
Arizona	One: as target audiences for comms plan that are STEM-focused, community-based organizations
Delaware	(1) Part of an SEA focus on providing equitable access to a well-rounded education; (2) POTENTIAL TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TOPIC: Course selection counseling to encourage under-represented students to enroll in courses that align with STEM
Idaho	ISDE allows LEAs to offer a variety of academic enrichment and extra-curricular activities aligned to state standards, one of which is STEM
Illinois	State is preparing a Tech for Teachers website, which provides direct resources for implementing STEM concepts such as coding opportunities, 3-d projects, makers, and digital portfolios to build digital literacy and marketable technology skills
Maryland	(1) Key SEA strategy around expanding access to STEM for all students, particularly women and youth of color; (2) provide opportunities for LEA's to apply for grants to expand STEM programs
Montana	Activities to support a well-rounded education include Montana Partnership with Regions for Excellence in STEM, which provides PD to STEM teachers via leaders from across the state
North Carolina	STEM Recognition Program began in 2013-14 for schools that demonstrated best practice in instruction and enrichment in the field
Washington	One of five core priorities from Superintendent: expand CTE and STEM programs w/ support of Microsoft, Boeing, and other relevant companies
